Passive Voice

We use the passive voice when we don't know who did the action or the action itself is more important.

We can only form a passive sentence when there is an object in the active sentence.

The passive voice is less usual than the active voice. But sometimes a statement in passive is more polite than in active voice.

The passive is formed with the verb to be and the past participle of the main verb.

Present Simple

am / is / are + past participle

The office is cleaned every day.

Past Simple

was / were + past participle

The office was cleaned at 5 o'clock.

Present Perfect

have / has + past participle

The office has already been cleaned.

Future Simple

will be + past participle
